

GTFA Football Camp Terms and Conditions

Arrival

Daily registers will be taken prior to the camp commencing, at lunchtime and finally at the end of the day. We politely emphasise prompt timekeeping at the start of the sessions, and also upon collection.

Start:	09.45	-	10.00
Morning:	10.00	-	12.00
Lunch:	12.00	-	13.00
Afternoon:	13.00	-	15.00
Finish:	15.00	-	15.15

Or adjust by difference where camp times are longer.

Extended Hours

Early drop off or late pick up can be arranged. Please contact us for further details and cost.

Cancellation

In the unfortunate event that GTFA must cancel a football camp, a full refund will be offered. GTFA will give no less than 3 working days notice before the start date.

Refunds & Cancellations

You have the right to cancel single bookings with 24 hours notice or 7 days notice for full week bookings you will receive a full refund. Payments must be paid in full prior to the camp commencing. If bank charges are incurred, these will be deducted from the refund.

Appropriate Clothing

Appropriate clothing and footwear must be provided to take part in sport. Football boots and shin pads must be worn at all times (non marking trainers for inside). Provide sun block and caps (April - September), waterproof, hat, gloves and change of clothes (October - March). We want your child to enjoy their experience.

Health Conditions

Make sure you notify us in advance if your child has any medical conditions, allergies, injuries or needs support.

Lunch

Provide your child a packed lunch and refreshments. FOOD CONTAINING NUTS are prohibited. We encourage healthy eating and will offer nutritional information to children attending GTFA football camps.

Photographic Policy

GTFA may take photographs and video footage for future promotions. If you wish to exclude your child, please make this clear in writing prior to the camp commencing.

Child Protection

All coaches are DBS checked, Paediatric / Emergency First Aid qualified and are hold a minimum of a Level 2 coaching qualification.

Camp Exclusions

GTFA reserves the right to remove an individual that is deemed to have an adverse affect on the smooth running and safety of other participants. Any such decision will be made by the camp director and without prejudice.
